## MINUTES BOARD OF EDUCATION UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 248 GIRARD, KS DECEMBER 10, 2015

The Board of Education of Unified School District 248 met at the Board Office on Thursday, December 10, 2015. President, Dale Shireman, called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. Aaron Callaway moved, Beth Murphy seconded the motion for the approval of the agenda with the addition of items #18 B-\$2,500.00 donation from the Girard Area Community Foundation for the Youth Association scoreboard and item #21 A-Surveillance cameras at the Girard Middle School, approval of the minutes of the previous meetings of November 12, 2015, approval of the treasurer's report and the bills be approved for payment, amounting to \$1,254,522.40. Motion carried. 7 - 0.

Beth Murphy moved, Tony Stonerock seconded the motion to approve the \$2,500.00 donation from the Community Foundation of Southeast Kansas-Champion for Learners and the \$2,500.00 donation for the Girard Area Community Foundation for the Youth Association portable score board grant. Motion carried. 7 - 0.

Tony Stonerock moved, Roger Breneman seconded the motion to approve a second semester work-study program for two High School students. Motion carried. 7 - 0.

Dave Goble moved, Aaron Callaway seconded the motion to enter into executive session at 6:41 pm for a period of 30 minutes, for the purpose of non-elected personnel, with the Board, School Attorney, Superintendent and Building Administrators present. Superintendent, Blaise Bauer, distributed the Superintendent's evaluation to the Board, for the preparation for next month.

The Board had the opportunity to report on the KASB State Convention, in Wichita, December 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>.

Principal's reports were presented in the Board packet.

Blaise Bauer reported to the Board on various issues.

Dave Goble reported about the SEK 637 Interlocal.
