- Students not selected for nonresident enrollment through the lottery selection process or due to a lack of capacity must reapply each year in which they wish to be considered for nonresident enrollment.

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### **Good standing criteria:**

- a. Applicants must have a minimum of a 2.0 GPA and no failed classes from the prior school year.
- b. The applicant must have maintained at least a 95% school attendance rate in the last school year, excluding absences that were excused under the school's attendance policy.
- c. Behavior record
  - (a) No out-of-school suspensions, expulsions, or excessive tardies.
  - (b) No repeat referrals for poor or incomplete schoolwork.
- d. The nonresident student or the student's parent or person acting as a parent provided false or fraudulent information in the application process;
- e. The student is currently under a period of suspension or expulsion from any Kansas school district, and such suspension or expulsion will not expire until after the next school year has begun;
- f. The nonresident student is not a resident of Kansas.

### **KSHSAA Eligibility**

Nothing in this policy or state law shall exempt a nonresident student who transfers into the district from the requirements of the Kansas State High School Activities Association ("KSHSAA") regarding eligibility to participate in KSHSAA activities.
